MANTHEY ROAD & KLO ROAD RESURFACING Project Description

Project Location:

Manthey Road: 1400' south of Klo Road (Lathrop City Limits) to Briggs Road; Mathews Road to 460' south of Leo Giron Road. Klo Road: West End to Manthey Road. See attached Vicinity Map.

Project Justification:

Manthey Road was original constructed by Caltrans in 1969 as I-5 Frontage Road (0.35' AC/0.60' AB/0.95' ASB). Boring done in 2001 show structural section consists of 0.30' AC, 0.42' AC. The northern project limits of Manthey Road is a multi-lane 60' wide roadway. Maintenance has consisted of being periodically chip sealed and widened along Hospital Road 20' to 27' as part of 1990 Capital Project. Resurfacing in 1999 with 0.17' AC over fabric, crack seal in 2019 and slurry seal in 2019. Manthey Road and Hospital Road had curb ramps updated in 2018-2019 as part of Sidewalk Accessibility Improvements.

The southern limits of Manthey Road has an average width of 32'. Maintenance has consisted of being periodically chip sealed and resurfaced from Roth Road to Briggs Road in 2002 with 0.21' AC over fabric.

Klo Road has a width of 21'. Original construction date and existing structural section are unknown. Klo Road was maintained by Road Maintenance to included crack seal and chip seal.

The northern portion of Manthey Road has a high amount of Alligator Cracking, a moderate amount of Block Cracking, Transverse and Longitudinal Cracks and Weathering. The Southern portion of Manthey Road has a high amount of Alligator and Block Cracking while being moderate to low with Transverse Cracking, Rutting, and Weathering. Klo Road has a high amount of Rutting with a moderate to low Alligator and Transverse Cracking.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

- 1. Resurfacing existing roadway on Manthey Road with 0.25' Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) (Type A), and on Klo Road with 0.17' HMA (Type A).
- 2. Repairing all pavement structural failure areas with full depth 0.50' HMA (Type A).
- 3. Conforming grind 8' of existing roadway in areas with curb, gutter and/or sidewalk. Areas with medians grind 0.25' full width of existing roadway. Replacing and conforming with 0.25' HMA (Type A).
- 4. Replenishing 4' wide shoulder backing: 2' (8%) and 2' to conform and 4' to conform as warranted.
- 5. Applying Penetration Treatment at all intersection radii plus 50' or to conform.
- 6. Constructing HMA (Type A) driveways.
- 7. Adjusting monument frames and covers.
- 8. Constructing 6'-8' HMA (Type A), Driveways (Type E) & (Type D).


Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **industrial** on Manthey Road, and primarily **rural with single family homes** on Klo Road.

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
