Project Title: Santa Rosa Creek Road Milepost 2.9 Slipout Repair (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SLO-35461-R4).

Project Location: The project will occur within Santa Rosa Creek, approximately one mile east of the intersection of Santa Rosa Creek Road and Dos Cruces Lane and three miles northeast from the town of Cambria, San Luis Obispo County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 014-131-060; Latitude 35.57519° North, Longitude -121.03148° West.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SLO-35461-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, County of San Luis Obispo Department of Public Works.

The project includes activities related to the construction of a soil nails and shotcrete retaining wall with micropile footing, placement of log structures, and willow stake planting along 260 linear feet of Santa Rosa Creek for bank stabilization.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 3/5/2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Mitigated Negative Declaration and subsequent Addendum prepared by the Lead Agencies for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
