**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** The purpose of this project is to maintain year-round road access to two (2) potable water tanks at Carnegie State Vehicular Recreation Area (SVRA) to comply with daily testing requirements. Project work will place 10-ft x 8-ft articulated concrete block mats along approximately 1,648 feet of existing dirt roads. A State Parks Equipment Operator will use a backhoe to place the mats and support staff will backfill around each mat with road base after placement.
