The Project Site is located in Southeast Los Angeles in the City of Commerce right-of-way at the Atlantic Boulevard and Telegraph Road intersection, Atlantic Boulevard and Eastern Avenue intersection, and a portion of the Commerce Mitsubishi dealership located south of the South Atlantic Boulevard and Telegraph Road intersection.

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The Project would provide road improvements to the Atlantic Boulevard and Telegraph Road intersection and Atlantic Boulevard and Eastern Boulevard intersection. Road improvements would consist of reconfiguration of a right-turn lane from northbound Atlantic Boulevard to south-eastbound Telegraph Road at the Atlantic Boulevard/Telegraph Road Intersection in the City of Commerce. The proposed Project would include an improved sidewalk, curb ramps, driveway modifications, street lighting, on-site lighting relocation, planter, and a catch basin relocation. The Project would also include striping and signal modifications at the intersection of Atlantic Boulevard and Telegraph Road and intersection of Atlantic Boulevard and Eastern Avenue.

Reasons why project is exempt:

The Project would consist of proposed road improvements including the reconfiguration of a right-turn lane from northbound Atlantic Boulevard to south-eastbound Telegraph Road at the Atlantic Boulevard/Telegraph Road Intersection in the City of Commerce. Minor alteration to the existing street would involve road reconfiguration for a right-turn lane which would improve safety conditions and would not expand road capacity. The proposed Project would also include an improved sidewalk, curb ramps, driveway modifications, street lighting, on-site lighting relocation, planter, and a catch basin relocation. The proposed Project would also include striping and signal modifications at the intersection of Atlantic Boulevard and Telegraph Road and the intersection of Atlantic Boulevard and Eastern Avenue. Therefore, the proposed Project would be categorically exempt under Class 1.
