LUCERNE AVENUE AND PARADISE AVENUE RESURFACING Project Description

Project Location:

Lucerne Avenue: West end to Paradise Avenue; Paradise Avenue: Interstate 205 Overpass to Paradise Cut Bridge. See attached Vicinity Map.

Project Justification:

Original construction date and existing structural section are unknown for both roads. Map of 1925 Pescadero Colony shows Paradise Avenue as Oak Avenue. A 1926 Map of Pescadero Colony shows both Lucerne Avenue and Paradise Avenue in the configuration they are in today. The roads have been periodically chip sealed by Road Maintenance with the most recent application occurring in 2023 for Paradise Avenue only.

Existing pavement has a fair amount of surface cracking (block, transverse, longitudinal, alligator), minor distortion in wheel tracks and isolated areas of structural failure. The surface of Lucerne Avenue is severely cracked and has numerous structural failures.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

- 1. Resurfacing existing roadway with 0.25' Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) (Type A) on Paradise Avenue. No paving fabric will be used.
- 2. Pulverizing (0.50') existing roadway on Lucerne Avenue, shape and compact. Resurfacing roadway (14' wide) with 0.17' HMA over 0.17' AB. No paving fabric will be used.
- 3. Repairing all pavement structural failure areas with full depth 0.50' HMA.
- 4. Placing 6' wide gravel shoulders: 2' at 8% and 4' to conform.
- 5. Applying Penetration Treatment at all intersection radii plus 50' or to conform.
- 6. Constructing HMA and frontages 8' in length from edge of pavement.
- 7. Placing one new survey monument box to finish grade.


Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily rural with single family homes.

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
