Commercial Vehicle Section (CVS) was requested to review the Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration related to a proposed Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Facility (CVEF) on State Route 118 (SR-118) in Ventura County. Upon review, CVS submits the following comments regarding the expected volume of traffic and the efficient use of the highway with this proposed construction project.

This location will have the greatest volume of commercial motor vehicle (CMV) traffic of any CVEF in California which is not located on a freeway. As a result, CMVs entering and exiting this CVEF may impact the expeditious flow of traffic on this segment of SR-118. As planning continues, we are hopeful that proper consideration is given to how CMV traffic from this CVEF will safely interact with pedestrians, bicycles, motorcycles, implements of husbandry, and the numerous other types of vehicles which utilize SR-118.
