Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

The proposed project would include regrading of a short section of an old deteriorating roadbed that leads from an existing parking area and trailhead along W.A. Barr Road to the shore of Lake Siskiyou. Construction will include the placement of boulders and cobbles above and below the ordinary high-water mark of Lake Siskiyou to return the shoreline to a gently sloping ramp that allows hand-carry paddle crafts a safe place to launch. The project will take place when lake levels are at their lowest, and no dewatering will be required.
