Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The Tipton Sidewalk Improvements Project includes pedestrian enhancements along Evans Road (between Avenue 152 and Lerda Avenue) and Woods Avenue (between Thompson Road and Newman Road) in Tipton near Tipton Elementary School District. The project involves installing curb & gutter, sidewalk, curb ramps, drive approaches, asphalt concrete paveouts, pedestrian facility-related drainage improvements, and a flashing beacon system at the existing crosswalk in front of Tipton Elementary School. Construction activities will include roadway excavation, placement of aggregate base and pavement, and signing/striping installation. Minor utility relocations may be needed to accommodate the project. The project aims to address drainage issues along Evans Road and Woods Avenue to enhance safety for pedestrians and bicyclists. Construction is anticipated to begin during the 3rd Quarter of 2025.
