

THORNTON ROAD RESURFACING 2024

Project Description

Project Location:

Thornton Road: Devries Road to 1,270 feet South of De Broggi Road. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

Project Justification:

The original construction date and pavement section for the 24-foot, two-lane Thornton Road are currently unknown. However, Thornton Road has undergone periodic chip sealing, with the latest application occurring in 2016.

The existing pavement exhibits a combination of transverse, longitudinal, and block cracking, with noticeable patch repairs along the edge of pavement, primarily along the southbound lane. Additionally, there are areas exhibiting alligator cracking and moderate rutting within the wheel path. The ride quality is less than comfortable due to an uneven pavement surface.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

1. Resurfacing existing roadway with 0.25' Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) (Type A).
2. Placing tapered edge along the edge of pavement.
3. Repairing all pavement structural failure areas with full depth 0.50' HMA (Type A).
4. Replenishing 6' wide Shoulder Backing: 2' @ 8% and 4' to conform.
5. Applying Penetration Treatment at all intersection radii plus 50' or to conform.
6. Placing 2 new survey monument frames and covers.
7. Performing Earthwork (Miscellaneous Areas) where the shoulder's elevation is higher than the pavement.


Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes.**

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
