

HARVEST ROAD PAVEMENT IMMEDIATE MINOR MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR PROJECT

Project Description

Project Location:

North 99 Frontage Road East, Harvest Road, and Brandywine Road. See attached Vicinity Map.

Project Justification:

Pavement failures on Harvest Road have been an ongoing issue for approximately 18 months. San Joaquin County Road Maintenance has been performing some pavement repairs on Harvest Road within the last 10 months.

The north side of Brandywine Road and the westbound lanes of Harvest Road are experiencing substantial pavement failures along their shoulders. Additionally, failures are evident on the east side of the road section in the northbound lane of the Highway 99 Frontage Road. These failures are characterized by significant dips in the road and fractured asphalt concrete (AC). Furthermore, sizable voids have formed in certain areas, posing a hazard to both drivers and pedestrians.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

1. Performing 0.25' and 0.50' pavement repairs along Brandywine Road, Harvest Road, and North 99 Frontage Road as specified by the Pavement Repair Location/Type List.

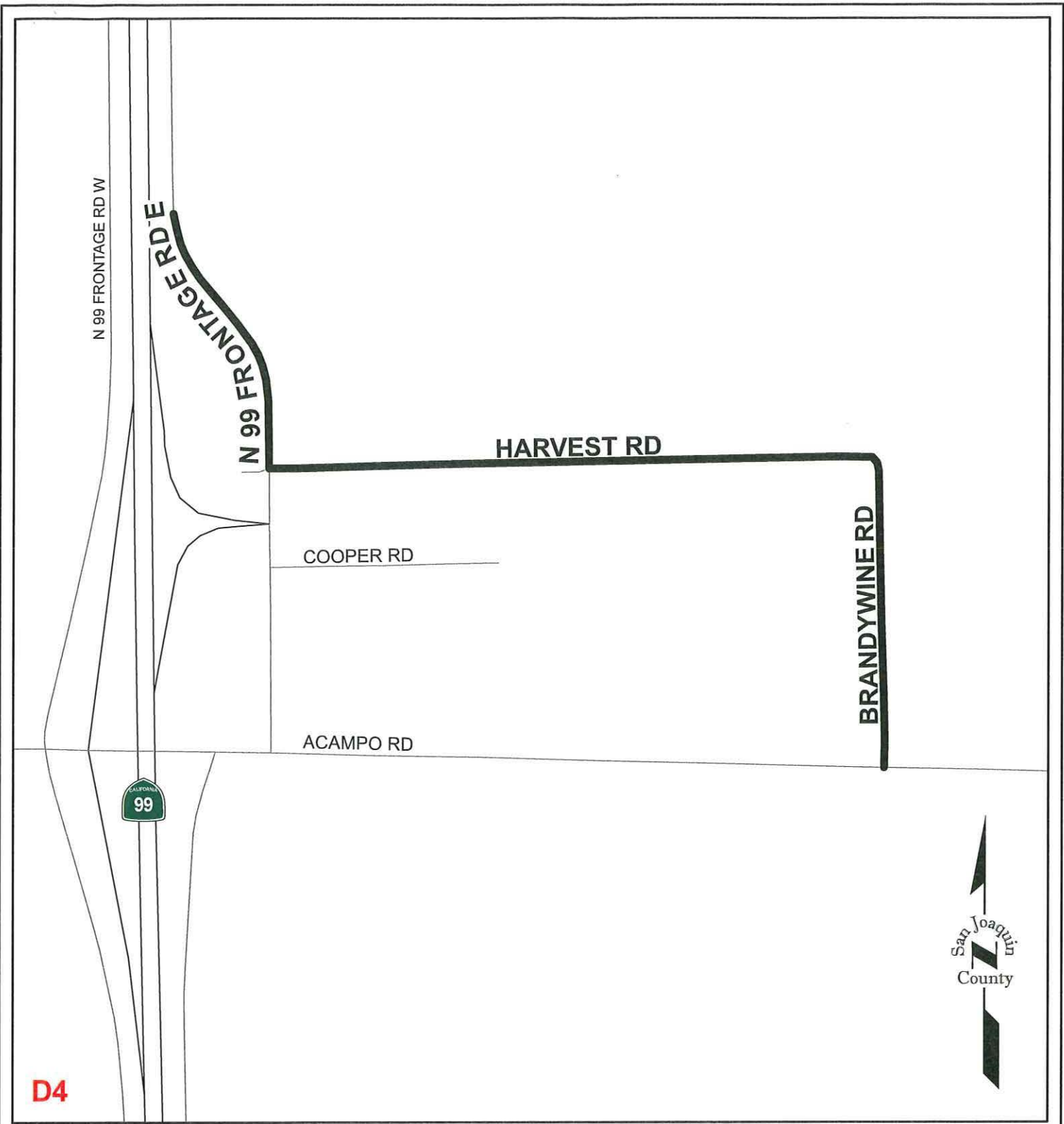
Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes.**

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
