### Project Approval

The California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) adopted the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration and approved the CAL FIRE Shasta-Trinity Unit Headquarters and Northern Region Headquarters Relocation on June 27, 2024.

### Project Location

The Project site is located on the eastern side of Venture Parkway in the northern portion of Lot 11 (Lot 11A) within the Stillwater Business Park in the City of Redding. The site is designated Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 054-220-032 in Shasta County. The Project Site corresponds to a portion of Section 23, Township 31 North, and Range 04 West (Mount Diablo Base and Meridian) of the "Enterprise, California" 7.5-minute quadrangle. The approximate center of the Project Site is located at latitude 40.523666° and longitude -122.280451°. The Project Site corresponds with County Assessor's Parcel number 054-220-032-000.

### Summary Project Description

The Project proposes the relocation of the existing CAL FIRE Shasta-Trinity Unit Headquarters and Northern Region Headquarters to a new co-located facility. The Project would allow CAL FIRE to operate in a safe and efficient manner, efficiently dispatch resources and services, enhance response times, and comply with the Governor's Executive Order B-18-12.

The State, as the Lead Agency, has approved the above-described Project and has made the following determinations:


Mitigation measures were required to be made a condition of approval of the Proposed Project;
