Project Description: (please use a separate page if necessary) The Dixide Fire began on July 13, 2021 by a PG&E powerline and was contained on October, 25, 2021. The wildfire burned 963,309 acres. It was the largest single source wildfire in recorded California history. The fire resulted in expansive stretches of fire-killed and fire-damaged trees adjecent to National Forest System roads, trails, and facilities managed by LNF ELRD that now present a safety hazard. The primary purpose of this project is to provide for the safe use of National Forest System roads, trails, and facilities to the public.
