Located along the west bank of the Sacramento River, approximately 6 miles north of the community of Glenn. Site 22922 (39.601659, -121.999206), 22924 (39.607688, -121.994278), Site 22925 (39.616041, -121.994450), Site 22928 (39.626918, -121.001421)

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

DWR has identified the need to replace four levee pipes at Sites 22922, 22924, 22925, and 22928. The levee pipe and potentially compromised levee backfill material would be removed and replaced. Site 22924 would include abandoning a portion of the existing pipe and relocating the outlet slightly south to avoid tree removal. New inlet and outlet structures would include the installation of headwalls, rock revetment, and grouted spillways, while pipe appurtenances may be replaced with pre-cast or cast in place concrete structures.
