Project Description: This project includes 2 applications:

- General Plan Map Amendment No. PA-2300135: General Plan Amendment to change the General Plan
 designation of a 5.90-acre portion of a 143.85-acre parcel from I/L (Limited Industrial) to I/W (Industrial
 Warehouse).
- Revisions of Approved Actions No. PA-1900295: A Revisions of Approved Actions application to remove Condition of Approval 1.j. from a previously approved Site Approval for a heavy machinery and construction equipment sales facility to allow on site services consistent with the proposed I/W (Warehouse Industrial) General Plan designation.

The Property is zoned C-FS (Freeway Service Commercial), AU-20 (Agriculture- Urban Reserve, 20-acre minimum), and I-W (Warehouse Industrial). The General Plan designation is C/FS (Freeway Service Commercial), A/UR (Agriculture-Urban Reserve) and I/L (Limited Industrial).

Exemption Reason:

Processed under the provisions of California Code of Regulations Section 15061(b)(3), which are exempt from CEQA.

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3). Section 15061(b)(3) states that "CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. Where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA." There is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment and, therefore, the project is not subject to CEQA.

Authority cited: Sections 21083 and 21110, Public Resources Code. Reference: Sections 21108, 21152, and 21152.1, Public Resources Code. Processed under the provisions of the California Code of Regulations Section 15304, which are exempt from CEQA.

This project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) per CEQA Guidelines Section 15304. Class 4 consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry and agricultural purposes

Processed under the provisions of the California Code of Regulations Section 15183(a), which are exempt from CEQA.

CEQA mandates that projects which are consistent with the development density established by existing zoning, community plan, or general plan policies for which an EIR was certified shall not require additional environmental review, except as might be necessary to examine whether there are project-specific significant effects which are peculiar to the project or its site. This streamlines the review of such projects and reduces the need to prepare repetitive environmental studies.
