PROJECT DESCRIPTION: An Administrative Use Permit application for a tractor trailer and heavy equipment dealership facility including equipment sales and repair. The project includes the construction of a 76,404-square-foot sales, rental, service, and warehouse building, a 25,275-square-foot sales, rental, service, and warehouse building, a 27,301-squarefoot repair shop, and a 3,967-square-foot wash and storage building. The project site will be served by Cal Water for water, on-site septic system for wastewater disposal, and an on-site stormwater pond.

The Property is zoned C-G (General Commercial) and the General Plan designation is C/G (General Commercial).

PROJECT LOCATION: The project site is on the southwest corner of S. French Camp Rd. and W. Yettner Rd., French Camp. (APN/Address: 193-060-11, -35 / 6001 S. French Camp Rd., French Camp) (Supervisorial District: 3)
