**Project Location Specific:** This project is in the City of Parlier and will occur at various locations along Parlier Ave from Academy Ave to Mendocino Ave, 3rd St from Newmark Ave to Fig Ave, Fig Avenue from South Ave to 3rd St, H St from 150 feet south of Stanislaus St to Tuolumne St, and at the intersection of Parlier Ave and Avila Ave.

**Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:**

The purpose of this project is to create safer school routes for students walking to school and to encourage increased use of biking and walking. The project includes the construction of ADA curb ramps and bulb-outs, the installation of enhanced safety crosswalk features including in-roadway lights and a HAWK system, and the installation of Class II bike lanes. This project is intended to benefit students who attend the school, residents and visitors of the City of Parlier.
