

BRADY ROAD RESURFACING 2024

Project Description

Project Location:

Brady Road: Manteca Road to the east end. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

Project Justification:

Original construction date and existing structural section are unknown. A survey map from 1917 shows Brady Road (then known as Melton Road) as a 40' right-of-way. The road has been periodically chip sealed by Road Maintenance with the last application in 2007. The road received a geosynthetic reinforced chip seal in 2015.

Existing pavement has a fair amount of surface cracking (block, transverse, longitudinal, alligator), minor distortion in wheel tracks and isolated areas of structural failure.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

1. Resurfacing existing roadway with 0.25' Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). No paving fabric will be used.
2. Repairing all pavement structural failure areas with full depth 0.50' HMA.
3. Performing earthwork (miscellaneous areas) on high shoulders as needed.
4. Placing 6' wide shoulders on both sides: 2' at 8% and 4' to conform.
5. Applying Penetration Treatment at all intersection radii plus 50' or to conform.
6. Constructing HMA and frontages 8' in length from edge of pavement.

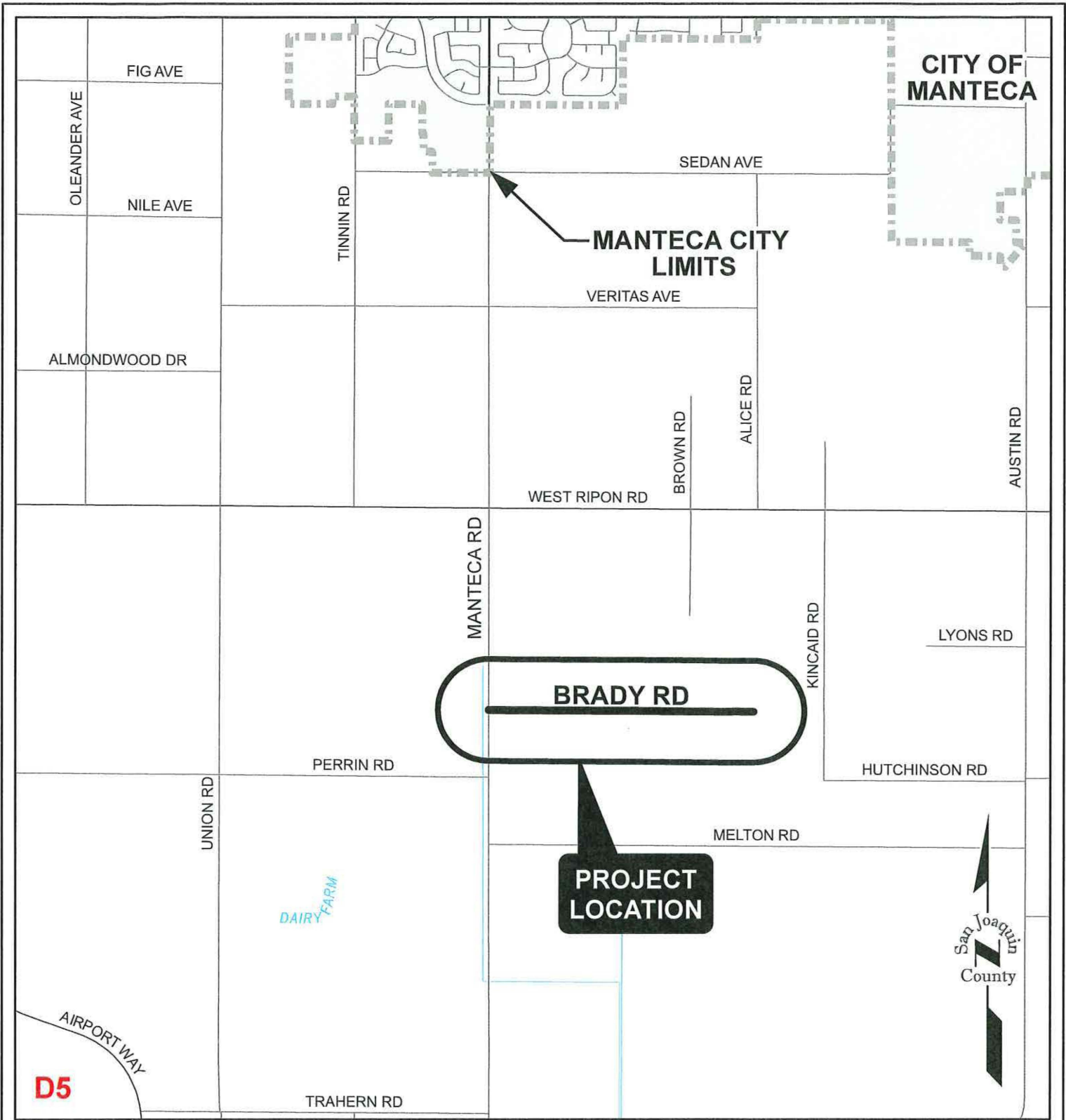
Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes.**

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

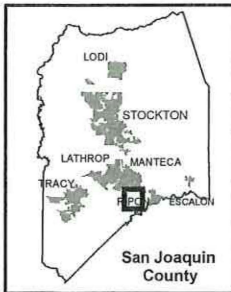
Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
