Description of Nature, Purpose, and Benefits of Project:

Project primary goals are to enhance oak woodland habitat, increase native grasses and grass functional groups, and increase pollinator foraging resources. The 2.5-acre project area includes the project components, as well as equipment access and staging. The project components include 1) acorn planting across 1 acre of blue oak woodland to increase oak regeneration, 2) native grass plug planting across 0.1 acre to increase herbaceous structural diversity and overwintering pollinator habitat, and 3) native wildflower seeding across 0.12 acre to increase native pollinator foraging resources.


