Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

This project is to infill, grade, and level a reclaimed quarry in two phases over five years to allow for the planting of a 131.58-acre site for agricultural production. Phase one will consist of filling the quarry with 1/3 of the total fill material. Phase 2 will consist of filling the quarry with the remaining 2/3 of the total fill material, which will bring the site to grade. Total fill quantity at the conclusion of the project will be approximately 654,321 cubic yards of fill dirt.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

The project proposes to infill, grade and level a reclaimed quarry. The project was referred to the San Joaquin Council of Governments, who as a condition of approval will require the applicant to participate in the San Joaquin County Multi-Species Habitat Conservation and Open Space Plan for any future ground disturbance related to the development of the subject site. This will mitigate any negative impacts associated with biological resources in the area.
