Project Location (Sonoma County): The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Schell Creek, in the County of Sonoma, State of California; Latitude 38.254746°, Longitude -122.425972°; 21895 Hyde Road, Sonoma, CA, 95476; Assessor's Parcel Number 186-083-011.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SON-42858-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Stacie McCambridge.

The project is limited to stabilization of the eroding stream bank with rock riprap. The placement of riprap will permanently impact approximately 100 linear feet and approximately 200 square feet of riparian habitat. Riprap will be placed from the top of bank and no equipment will enter the stream. Access and staging will occur via an existing developed backyard. No trees will be removed, only minor trimming as necessary to place the riprap. No water will be present during work.
