Title: Diablo Canyon Intake Cove Dredging

Applicant: Pacific Gas and Electric Company


Location: Sovereign land located in and adjacent to the Pacific Ocean, near Avila Beach and Morro Bay, San Luis Obispo County.

Description: Amendment of Lease Number 9347, a General Lease – Industrial Use, effective April 4, 2024, for one-time maintenance dredging of approximately 70,000 cubic yards within the Diablo Canyon Power Plant intake cove and deposition of dredged material offshore of Morro Bay State Park.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on April 4, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A substitute document prepared under a certified state regulatory program was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15251).
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

An environmental analysis document (Coastal Development Permit #9-23-0599) was granted on March 14, 2024, for this project by the California Coastal Commission (CCC) under its certified program (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15251, subd. (c)). The State Lands Commission has reviewed and considered the information therein, concurred with the CCC's determination, and used the CCC document as a substitute Negative Declaration equivalent under CEQA.
