Title: Issuance of General Lease – Recreational Use – A4331

Location: Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 200 Pine Street, near Tahoma, Placer County

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use beginning April 4, 2024, for a term of 10 years, for continued use of two existing mooring buoys, removal of an existing mooring buoy and an existing boat ramp, and construction and use of a new pier with boat lift and catwalk.

Exempt Status:

Reasons for exemption:

Issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use for the above-mentioned structures will cause only a minor physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemptions apply.
