Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. COL-38088 -R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Erik Foraker.

The project is limited to maintenance of approximately 0.6 miles of an existing irrigation drainage canal adjacent to the western bank of Angel Slough, south of Gridley-Colusa Road in Colusa County, CA. Accumulated sediment and debris within the canal will be removed using an excavator and drag-line from the existing road.
