MEADOW AVENUE STORM DRAIN INLET INSTALLATION Project Description

Project Location:

1363 Meadow Avenue. See attached Vicinity Map.

Project Justification:

Flooding has been observed in the front area of the property located at 1363 Meadow Avenue due to the absence of a Storm Drain Inlet (SDI) to manage storm water runoff. The proposed project entails the installation of a new SDI within the property's softscape area, with authorization from San Joaquin County Right of Way. This new SDI will be integrated into the current storm water runoff collection system to mitigate flooding issues.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

- Removing approximately 256 square feet of existing softscape area and replacing with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) swale; 3" of Asphalt Concrete (AC) over 4" of compacted Aggregate Base (AB). Grade swale to direct water flow towards new SDI.
- 2. Tie into existing SDI: Install 12" cross pipe, back fill and compact. Cap with HMA.


Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily residential with single family homes.

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased fewer flooding within the project's vicinity.
