In accordance with the State CEQA Guidelines, the City of Santa Rosa has prepared this notice to inform agencies and interested parties that it is releasing an Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Samuel L. Jones Hall Homeless Shelter Improvements Project.

Project Description and Location

The City of Santa Rosa owns and operates the Samuel L. Jones Hall Homeless Shelter (Sam Jones Hall) located at 4020 Finley Avenue in the southwest incorporated portion of the City. The Sam Jones Hall is a City of Santa Rosa-owned facility critical to providing shelter and services to persons experiencing homelessness, which operates for 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The Project proposes to enhance the current shelter facility to better accommodate the recent increase in occupants and the quality of the community services provided and is not an evaluation of any impacts resulting from this previously approved permitted use that was determined to be CEQA exempt. The Project includes exterior improvements such as ornamental landscaping features, aboveground community service facilities, additional asphalt parking and a new dedicated entrance driveway, pathways, curb and gutter improvements, pedestrian sidewalks and associated facilities, and modular shower and restroom facilities. Improvements would occur within the Sam Jones Hall site, with some ancillary improvements occurring along Finley Avenue.

The Project site is listed on the Cortese List twice, once on the HWTS (Hazardous Waste Tracking System) database and once on the HAZNET (Haz. Waste Info. Center) database related to the historical disposal of materials containing PCBs and asbestos during historical interior building renovations in 2005. There are no recorded violations associated with these database listings.

Providing Comments

A 30-day public review period will extend from April 24, 2024 to May 24, 2024. The IS/MND will be available for public review online https://cippublic.srcity.org/ProjPages/2365.html or at the following location:

After the review period closes, the Santa Rosa City Council will consider a recommendation to adopt the IS/MND for the Project during a regularly scheduled public meeting.
