Project Description: The facility operates under a full solid waste facility permit pursuant to Title 14 §17403.7 which requires the facility to undergo a permit review at least once every five years. Accordingly, the proposed action includes amendments to the Report of Facility Information (RFI) in the form of a Transfer Processing Report (TPR); amendments reflect updates to current operating practices where co-mingled green/food waste within the facility is no longer tarped overnight and waste receiving hours for commercial customers has been updated. The TPR's Attachment P has been updated to reflect the facility's current safety equipment and load checking requirements. It further corrects typographical, grammatical, and formatting errors in the TPR.


