Project Location - Specific:

The project is located along 9th Street at Lassen Avenue (SR 269) and Railroad Avenue, in the City of Huron.

Project Location - City: Huron Project Location - County: Fresno

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The existing 9th Street and Huron Avenue intersect Lassen Avenue (SR 269) at angles of 65° and 70°, respectively. The project proposes to realign 9th Street with Railroad Avenue, to eliminate access to Huron Ave from SR 269. The City will be constructing a new La Placita Park in the area between 9th St and Huron Ave. A new park will mean increased numbers of pedestrians, and the intersection needs to be made safer. The realignment would calm traffic around La Placita Park and will fix one of the major misaligned intersections in the center of Huron. Construction activities will include demolition, clearing and grubbing, the installation of 1,338 tons of Class II Aggregate Base, and 399 tons of Type 'A' Hot Mix Asphalt. The project will also include the construction of 717 linear feet of concrete curb and gutter, 4,309 square feet of concrete sidewalk, two (2) Case 'A' curb ramps and 280 square feet commercial driveway approach.
