NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION MONTEREY COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Monterey County Housing & Community Development has prepared a draft Mitigated Negative Declaration, pursuant to the requirements of CEQA, for a General Development Plan (Jimenez Salvador Jr Tr [The Red Barn], File Number PLN140602) at 1000 North Highway 101, Aromas (main APN 141-013-035-000) (see description below). The project does not involve the burning of municipal wastes, hazardous waste, or refuse-derived fuel and is not on a list enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

Written comments on this Mitigated Negative Declaration will be accepted from **April 17, 2024** to **May 17, 2024**. Comments can also be made during the public hearing.

Project Description: Use Permit Amendment to ZA-3117 and ZA-3269 to amend the parking and sales area and expanded operations as described in a General Development Plan. The properties are located at 1000, 1050, 1060 and 1150 North Highway 101, Aromas (Assessor Parcel Numbers 141-013-034-000, 141-013-035-000, 141-013-037-000 & 141-131-025-000), North County Area Plan.
