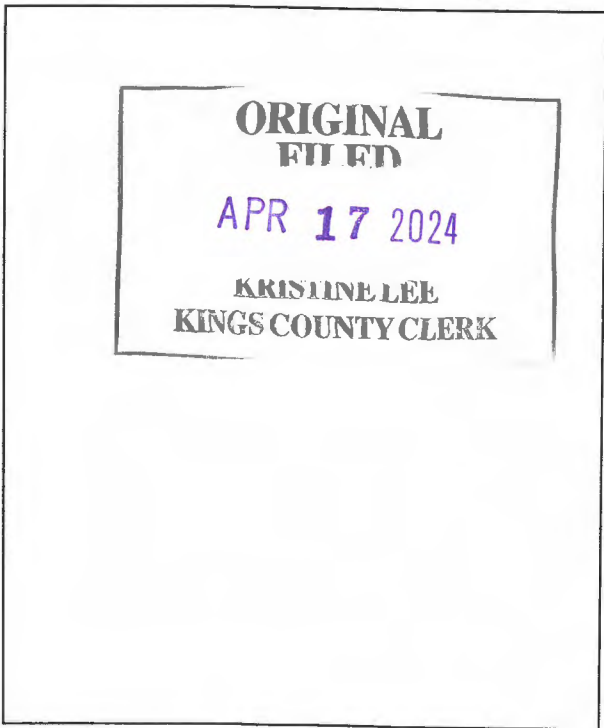

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: This project is exempt because the construction activities proposed by this project will be minor alterations of existing facilities and do not include an expansion of use of the existing roadway or adjacent developments. The largest components of this project will be the

reconstruction of sidewalk, and the construction of bulb-outs. This project does not include the construction of any new housing or commercial structures, additional automobile lanes within the existing roadway, nor additional parking facilities; thus, the project will not result in increased vehicle trips.
