Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

On April 25, 2024, the Internal Services Department of the County of Los Angeles executed Community Broadband Network Services Work Order CBN-1 East Los Angeles (Work Order) that provides for the following future potential activities which are not yet approved. Installation and management of core network infrastructure equipment by a Contractor to provide new, low-cost internet access services in neighborhoods experiencing a digital divide where it is estimated that 20 percent or more of households lack internet service subscriptions. Administrative activity, including, design, planning, supportive and other activity is also included in the Work Order. The execution of the agreement is an administrative activity which will not authorize any activity that is considered a project under CEQA to proceed.

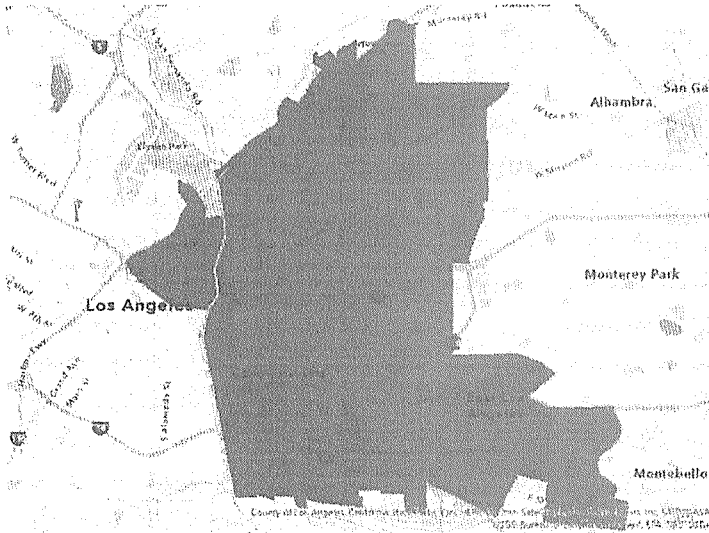

ATTACHMENT A

PROJECT LOCATION:

The geographic area of the Work Order is composed of the following neighborhoods: Boyle Heights, Lincoln Heights, Montecito Heights, El Sereno, and the East Los Angeles neighborhood. This geographic area has communities both incorporated in the City of Los Angeles, as well as Los Angeles County Unincorporated Areas.



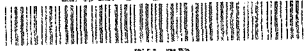
It has a total geographic area of 25.4 square miles with the 110 Interstate highway bordering the north end of the area, the LA river generally bordering the west end of the area (with the exception of a small area between the 101 and the 110), E Olympic Blvd and the I-5 generally bordering the south end of the area, and the Long Beach Freeway generally bordering the east end of the area (with the exception of Garfield Ave on the SE end and Winchester Ave on the NE end).

Although this geographic area is covered by the Work Order, no individual Projects subject to CEQA are approved by execution of the Work Order.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:

The Work Order approval does not constitute a Project under the California Public Resources Code Section 21065, as it does not authorize activities which may cause either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and is an administrative activity of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. Prior to approval of any activity that would be considered a project under the Work Order, a description of activity proposed at each site would be necessary and a subsequent written Notice to Proceed by the County would be required.

This Work Order includes requirements for the Contractor to design the core network infrastructure system to be installed, including the proposed locations where the equipment is proposed to be installed. The implementation activities in the Work Order that could have the potential to cause significant effect on the environment require a written Notice to Proceed from the County to the Contractor prior to those activities being initiated. Before the written Notice to Proceed is issued, the Contractor is required to utilize third-party subcontractor(s) to conduct feasibility studies on the proposed locations in its core network infrastructure design. The County will make a CEQA determination based on the Project Record after its own third-party contractor review of the Contractor's feasibility studies.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Section 15061(b)(3), the Work Order is also exempt from CEQA, under the common sense exemption that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity may have a significant effect on the environment. Absent a Notice to Proceed, no work that would be considered a Project may proceed under the Work Order.

The action is an administrative activity of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b). Additional activities included in the Work Order include the creation of design documents, plans, and work schedules, project management services, contract compliance activities, conducting meetings, ordering of equipment, deployment preparation, maintenance and operations of the internet service, acquisition of subscribers, provisioning and delivering of internet services to subscribers, community engagement, marketing, and reporting services, none of which meet the definition of a Project under CEQA.
