The project is an application for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP23-0015) proposing the construction and operation of a new unmanned wireless communication facility located at 20886 Dog Bar Road, Grass Valley, in southeast Nevada County. The proposed facility will be designed as a one-hundred twenty-nine foot (129) tall faux pine tree (monopine) with entennas at a tip height of one-hundred twenty-nine foot (129) tall faux pine tree. The facility will be contained within a 30 x 30 (900 squere feet) Verizon lease area that will be surrounded with eight-foot tall chain-link fencing with a gate and a Knox Box entry system. The loase area will contain three equipment cabinets, a diesel generator, a PG&E transformer, and other communication-related equipment. The site will be accessed by an existing 12-foot wide dirt access road with a hammerhead turn-around at the and. Vegetation thinning to reduce fire hazard will occur along the access road and around the tower lease area. Approximately 550 feet of underground power and fiber cables are proposed to be trenched from the lease area to a PG&E pole and Verizon Wireless fiber point of connection.
