Section 15269 (b)(c) Emergency Project: The Statutory Exemption under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15269(c) Emergency Projects applies to specific actions necessary to prevent or mitigate an emergency. The project involves emergency spill response actions to address an underground fuel pipe leak detected during an integrity check/verification of the existing underground fuel pipe.


Section 15301 Existing Facilities (Class 1): The Class 1 Categorical Exemption consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. The project involves specific actions necessary to mitigate leaking of an existing underground fuel pipe involving no expansion of existing or former use.
