**MESSAGE:** On May 9, 2024, Lake County published an IS/MND for zone change and general plan amendment (RZ 23-02 and GPAP 23-02). Following the publication of the IS/ND, staff became aware that the project number listed on the first page of the ND was wrong. Please repost the revised ND.
