**Project Location:** The Project to be completed is located in the Russian River watershed, approximately 1.4 miles east of the City of Ukiah, County of Mendocino, State of California. The Project is located in Section 21, T15N, R12W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Ukiah U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 179-100-03; latitude 39.1528 and longitude -123.1830 at point of diversion #1 (POD; Hopper) and APN 171-151-03; Latitude 39.1517 and Longitude -123.1818 at POD #2 (Watson), for use on APNs 179-100-02, 179-100-03, 179-141-06, 179-141-07, and 179-151-03.
