NORTH 99 FRONTAGE ROAD EAST RESURFACING

Project Description

Project Location:

North 99 Frontage Road East: 530' North of Armstrong Road to Harney Lane. **See attached Vicinity Map.**

Project Justification:

The original roadway was constructed in 1958 over 2" of Asphalt Concrete (AC) and 8" of Aggregate Base (AB) with prime coat. The existing 26' roadway has 8' shoulder to the east of the roadway. The roadway has been periodically chip sealed by Road Maintenance with the most recent occurring in 2017.

The existing pavement consists of high block cracking, and heavy alligator cracking. The existing pavement also has high transitional, longitudinal, and edge cracking throughout the project limits.

Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

1. Resurfacing existing roadway with 0.17' Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) (Type A)
2. Repairing all pavement structural failure areas with full depth 0.25' HMA (Type A).
3. Replenishing 4' wide shoulder backing: 2' (8%) and 2' to conform.
4. Applying Penetration Treatment at all intersection radii plus 50' or to conform.
5. Constructing 8' HMA (Type A) driveways.
6. Conforming grind along curb.
7. Reconstructing traffic signal vehicle detection loops at the Harney Lane and North 99 Frontage Road East Intersection.
8. Planing all raised cracks to match the existing roadway grade.

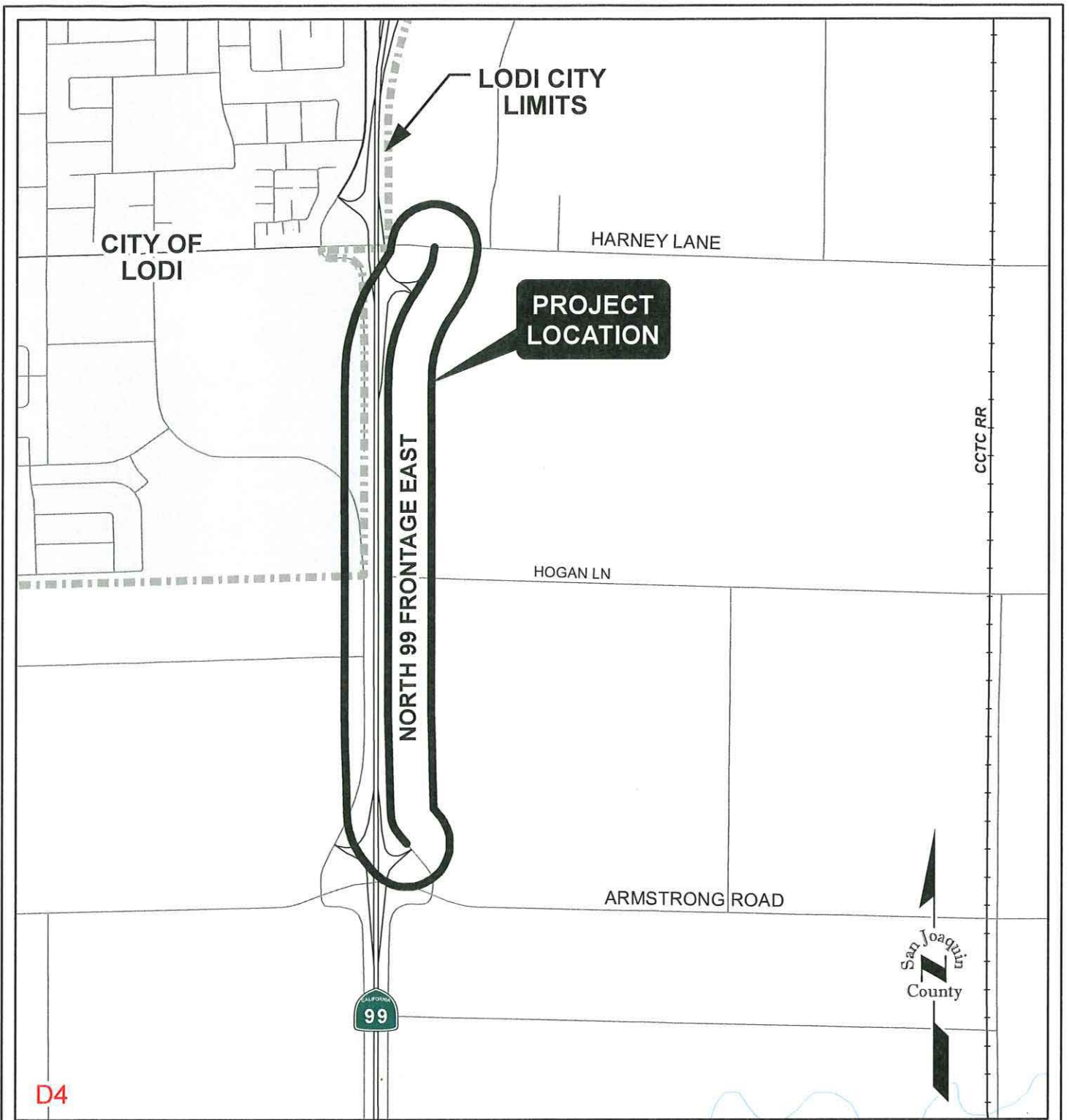
Environmental Setting:

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **rural with single family homes.**

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15th to September 1st.

Beneficiaries:

The public will see increased safety and fewer hazards with this well-maintained road. Overall, there will be reduced maintenance concerns and more reliability within the project area.
