# MORADA ACRES WATER SYSTEM REHABILITATION PROJECT Project Description

#### **Project Location:**

Morada Acres Maintenance District. See attached Vicinity Map.

#### **Project Justification:**

Morada Acres Maintenance District was formed in 1952 and currently serves water to 32 properties. Existing water mains were installed in 1955 and consists of 4" to 6" steel piping. The district has a existing steel hydropneumatics tank that was installed in 1961.

The existing water distribution system is aging causing water mains and service laterals to leak, and a leaking hydropneumatics tank. Residential water service connections are unmetered.

### Scope of Work:

The project will consist of:

 Rehabilitate the Morada Acres Maintenance District water system by replacing approximately 2,600 feet of pipelines along with necessary valves, 32 water service laterals, a hydropneumatics tank, 6 fire hydrants, and various pipeline appurtenances. In addition, the project will install new water meters on all service connections. All new piping will be installed within County Right of Way and the hydropneumatics tank will be installed on a County owned parcel.


#### **Environmental Setting:**

In these portions of the San Joaquin County, land usage is primarily **residential with single family homes.** 

There are many large trees adjacent to the project area. Nesting and migratory birds, protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, may nest within these trees. Furthermore, the Swainson's Hawk, a raptor species of concern within the State of California and listed as threatened may nest adjacent to or within the project area. A pre-construction survey for nesting Swainson's Hawks and other migratory birds is recommended if construction is scheduled to occur from February 15<sup>th</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup>.

#### Beneficiaries:

The public will see decreased maintenance needed for the water distribution system, resulting in smoother operations. Additionally, the district will conserve water by eliminating water losses through leaks in the water main.
