The project proposes residential, commercial/retail, and industrial uses on approximately 186 acres. The EIR will analyze two theoretical buildout scenarios, each of which are reflective of potential buildout consistent with the Specific Plan's development standards. The buildout scenarios are described as follows: 1. Maximum Buildout Scenario: A mixed-use development containing 1,806,290 square feet of industrial on 92.8 ac., up to 3,240 multi-family residential units and 20,000 square feet of commercial/retail use on 75.1 ac; and 2. Scenario #2: A mixed-use development containing 1,806,290 square feet of industrial use on 92.8, up to 1,237 multi-family residential unils and 71,600 square feet of commercial uses and a 128-key hotel in PA 1, 2 and 3. The project proposes a General Plan Amendment to amend the current General Plan land use designations from Mixed-Use Neighborhood (MUN) and Regional Commercial (RC) to Specific Plan (SP), and a Zone Change to revise the existing zoning designation of Mixed-Use Neighborhood (MUN) and Regional Commercial (RC) to SP.
