The Section 2081(a) permit authorizes the applicant to potentially capture coho salmon, Chinook salmon, and steelhead trout during surveys. The applicant will conduct research from May - November of chii-la'-ihsrik (redtail surfperch) through the use of hook & line baited dropper loop and hook & line - Carolina rig through December 31, 2027.
