#### NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

## **Project Title:**

2024 Neighborhood Traffic Management Projects

#### **Control Number:**

## **Project Location:**

The Project will occur within the County right-of-way (ROW) along several surface streets (see attached map) in unincorporated Sacramento County.

#### APN:

All work will be done within the County ROW.

# **Description of Project:**

The project consists of placing asphalt concrete speed tables, speed tables with pedestrian paths, speed tables with half pedestrian paths, speed bumps, speed bumps with pedestrian paths and speed bumps with half pedestrian paths at various locations within the County. The project will not result in any changes to the paved area, the traffic capacity, or the pavement striping configuration of the affected roads. Location maps for the proposed project are attached.

#### **Exempt Status:**

Categorical Exemption (PRC Section 21084; CEQA Guidelines Sections 15300 -15333):

- CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 Existing Facilities
- CEQA Guidelines Section 15303 New Construction of Conversion of Small Structures

### Reasons why project is exempt:

The project will install speed tables, speed bumps, and corresponding signage within the existing County ROW. The Project will not expand the use of the facilities, and is being done to improve pedestrian safety and access and is therefore exempt from the provisions of CEQA.

# Section 15300.2-Exceptions

Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines, Exceptions, provides conditions under which categorical exemptions are inapplicable. Review of the Project indicates that it will not violate any of the exceptions, as described in the following section.

- 1. The project will occur in certain specified sensitive environments or locations;
  - The Project sites are fully developed streets/roads within urbanized communities and are not considered environmentally sensitive.
- 2. Cumulative impacts will be considerable because successive projects of the same type will occur at the same place over time;
  - The Project consists of improvement to existing facilities and will not result in cumulative environmental impacts.
- 3. There is a reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances;
  - There are no known unusual circumstances that will have a significant effect on the environment.
- The project may result in damage to scenic resources, including but not limited to trees, historic buildings, rock outcroppings, or similar resources within a highway officially designated as a scenic highway;
  - The Project is not located in the vicinity of a highway officially designated as a scenic highway. Therefore, the project will not result in damage to scenic resources or similar resources within a highway that is officially designated as a scenic highway.
- 5. The project is located on a site which is included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code; or
  - The Project site is not included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code. Therefore, the Project will not have an impact related to being located on a hazardous waste site.
- 6. The project may cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historic resource.

The project site does not contain any historic resources and will not cause an adverse change in the significance of a historic resource.
