Project Location: The Project will occur at one location within an unnamed tributary to the Kern River approximately 0.5 miles southeast of the intersection of California Highway 178 and Kernville Road, located in the town of Lake Isabella, Kern County, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 485-080-28-00; Latitude 35.622978° North, Longitude -118.480600° West.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed an Amendment to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-KER-33258-R4, issued to Southern California Edison.

The Agreement authorizes the removal of one 40-foot-tall, 10-inch diameter wood utility pole (Pole 2253962E) and replacement with a new 45-foot-tall, 13.7-inch diameter composite pole. The pole location will be accessed on foot from Highway 178. The Amendment changes the method of pole installation to include placement by helicopter and to allow installation of a sonotube around the new pole.
