Project Title: SWC Ave L and 10th St. Lancaster (Western Joshua Tree Conservation Act (WJTCA) Incidental Take Permit No. 1927-ITP-2024-054-05 (ITP))

Project Location (include county): The SWC Ave L and 10th St. Lancaster (Project) is located at Assessor Parcel Number's (APN) 3109-026-047, 3109-026-048, and 3109-026-049 within the Lancaster, Los Angeles (see Figures 1-3). The Project is located approximately 34.659413, -118.148470. The Project is bounded by 10th Street to the East and Avenue L to the North (Project Site).

Project Description: This proposed project involves 3.72 acres of development to build a drive-through restaurant, drive-through car wash, and electronic vehicle charging stations with temporary pavement, perimeter sidewalk, curb, gutter, streetlights and utilities. Project Activities include vegetation removal, grading, and road construction.


The Project will result in incidental take of 21 western Joshua trees (*Yucca brevifolia*) which is protected under the WJTCA and the California Endangered Species Act. The WJTCA ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of western Joshua tree that may occur as a result of Project implementation.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as [the lead agency / a responsible agency] approved the above-described project on the date signed below and made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:
