DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: A portion of an existing pedestrian asphalt access ramp approximately 8'-10' in width has disappeared due to localized bluff failure, and ongoing environmental conditions threaten the remaining portions. Before designing a repair or access alternative, this project will allow for technical studies and investigations to determine a redesign. The project's initial scoping recommended several actions for repair however the project now recommends technical studies and investigations to determine an appropriate redesign or public access alternative. This may include Geotechnical Borings, Visual Surveys, UAV Flights, Photographing and Mapping, and Foot Surveys.
