Project Location: The Project is located at 8131 37th Ave, Sacramento 95824 (APN: 027-0360-023-0000) in Sacramento City.

County: Sacramento

Project Description:

The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code Division 10, Chapter 2, Section 26012, approved a Cannabis License submitted on July 1, 2019, by Bryan Mangang of All in Alliance Inc. The local Zoning Administrator approved a Conditional Use Permit (Z17-110) for marijuana cultivation on December 5, 2017. Bryan Mangang requested a transition from a provisional license to annual license for a Specialty Indoor license. The project involves the use of an existing 9,200 industrial building in the City's Light Industrial (M-1S) zone.

Project Activities:

The Project will consist of cannabis cultivation on a 0.45-acre lot within an existing 9,200 industrial building. Minor additions include a 500 square foot extension to the building and new ground mounted mechanical equipment.
