**Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:** The San Diego Unified Port District (District) Homeland Security Program helps to identify risks and threats within San Diego Bay to ensure regional security. This includes leveraging existing technology to address the security and safety of the District. One current camera sensor being used to monitor the San Diego Bay, referred to as WAVCam, is located in Point Loma. This WAVCam is functional, however a new, improved version has been developed by the manufacturer, Innovative Signal Analysis, Inc (ISA).

The original Generation 1 WAVCam camera was installed as part of Port Security Grant Program (PSGP) funding which was awarded in Fiscal Year (FY) 2014. The District was awarded additional funding through the PSGP in FY 2022 for the Maritime Domain Awareness (MDA) Detection Capability Project which includes upgrading the current camera sensor at Point Loma. In order to upgrade the current sensor, a Generation 2 WAVCam camera sensor manufactured by ISA, Inc. will be purchased and installed through the execution of an equipment purchase and service agreement. The current Generation 1 equipment will be relocated to the Joint Harbor Operation Center (JHOC) at the US Coast Guard Sector San Diego, providing extended coverage, tracking and alerts.

Work for the proposed project would involve the use of a utility truck with a bucket to raise personnel and equipment to the work site. There would be no trenching or ground disturbance required for the proposed project.

**Reason Why Project is Exempt:** The proposed project is determined to be Categorically Exempt pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines and the Section of the District's Guidelines for Compliance with CEQA as identified above. This is appropriate for the proposed project because the project involves an equipment purchase and service agreement that would involve no expansion of use beyond that previously existing and would consist of the purchase, installation and maintenance of camera equipment on existing facilities. A Notice of Exemption was filed on October 15, 2014 for the FY 2014 PSGP which analyzed five security-related projects including the original installation of the Generation 1 camera in Point Loma. Section 3.a. of the District's CEQA Guidelines is as follows:

Project # 2024-050

- 3.a. Existing Facilities (SG § 15301) (Class 1): Includes operation, repair, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that previously existing.

As to the relocation of the Generation 1 system, the Sector San Diego district unit in which the JHOC building exists is eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). However, the property's historical resource status under CEQA remains undetermined as there has been no State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) concurrence. The District has determined that there would not be a substantial adverse change to any potentially historic resource because the Project will merely involve the installation of one (1) external camera here. The camera is not a permanent fixture and can be removed; further, the camera is a similar color to the exterior of the building. Furthermore, four (4) cameras of similar size are currently installed on the roof of the JHOC building. Therefore, the Project would not materially impair the architectural integrity nor the historical significance of this potentially historic resource.

Therefore, the District has determined none of the six exceptions to the use of a categorical exemption apply to this project (CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2).
