Project Location - Specific: The project site is located along Crest Drive, at the intersection of Fox Hill Drive and the northernmost driveway to Valley View Elementary School.

Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project: The project will install new Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) curb ramps, rapid rectangular flashing beacons (RRFBs), pedestrian push button assemblies, and high-visibility crosswalk markings to enhance the visibility of pedestrians, and in particular students during drop off and pick up times..

Reasons why the project is exempt. Class 1 consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. The types of "existing facilities" itemized below are not intended to be all-inclusive of the types of projects which might fall within Class 1. The key consideration is whether the project involves negligible or no expansion of use. Examples include but are not limited to:

(c) Existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purposes of public safety, and other alterations such as the addition of bicycle facilities, including but not limited to bicycle parking, bicycle-share facilities and bicycle lanes, transit improvements such as bus lanes, pedestrian crossings, street trees, and other similar alterations that do not create additional automobile lanes).

(f) Addition of safety or health protection devices for use during construction of or in conjunction with existing structures, facilities, or mechanical equipment, or topographical features including navigational devices.

The project as proposed is consistent with the exemption class description noted above and is exempt pursuant to Class 1 of the CEQA Guidelines.
