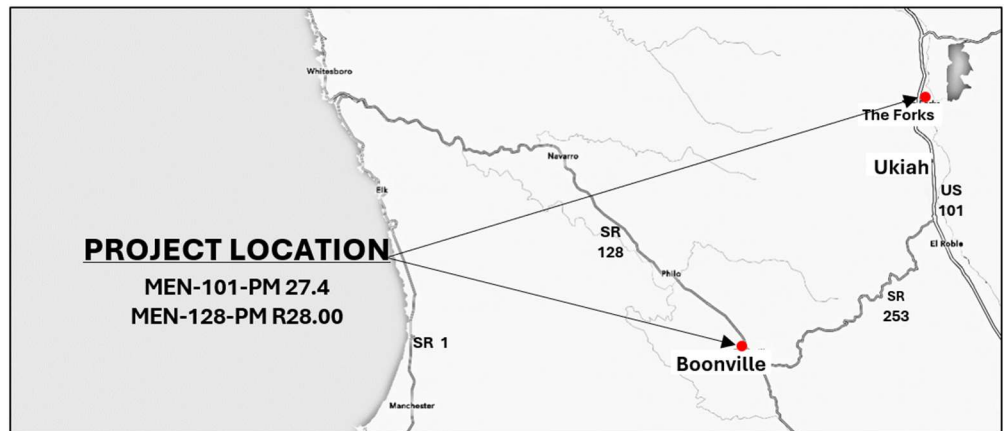
## Notice of Intent to Adopt a Negative Declaration Proposed Rehab Multiple Transportation Related Facilities Project for Boonville and Ukiah Maintenance Stations, Mendocino County

### WHAT IS BEING PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to improve existing Maintenance Stations (MSs) in Ukiah on US 101 at post mile 27.40 in Mendocino County by installing a bulk fuel island, replacing an existing records/fuel log building, and installing electric vehicle charging stations. Improvements to the existing MS in Boonville on US 101 at post mile R28.00 would include replacing a failing materials storage structure and installing electric vehicle charging stations. The proposed work involves sites on a list enumerated under Section 65962.5 of the Government Code pertaining to hazardous wastes.

### WHAT IS AVAILABLE

The environmental document for this project is called an Initial Study with Proposed Negative Declaration. The document will be available for public review Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from **May 19, 2024 to June 21, 2024**, at the Caltrans District 1 office, 1656 Union Street, Eureka, CA 95501.
