**Project Description:** Improve two existing Department Maintenance Stations in Mendocino County. At the Ukiah Maintenance Station adjacent to US 101, work would include installing a permanent fuel island with canopy and demolishing and replacing a storage building. At the Boonville Maintenance Station adjacent to SR 128, work would include replacing the existing substandard materials storage building with a new materials storage building. Both Maintenance Stations would receive a new Level 2 and a Level 3 electric vehicle charging station. The project locations were identified on the Hazardous Waste and Substances Sites list as sites with historic leaking underground storage tanks, in Mendocino County.
