DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Issue Right of Entry to the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) for access to conduct a practice deployment of the Sensitive Site Strategy Evaluation Program (SSSEP) strategies for Leo Carrillo State Park (South Beach) to be deployed in the event of a nearby oil spill. CDFW's SSSEP evaluates strategies and selects sites statewide that are particularly vulnerable to an oil spill. These areas are identified in Area Contingency Plansand are rich in sensitive resources such as fish, birds, and marine mammals. Many also include habitat for wildlife breeding, nesting, and feeding.
