## Glenn-Colusa Irrigation District 2024 Project Water Transfer to Sutter Mutual Water Company: Reasons Why Project is Exempt from California Environmental Quality Act

As documented by Glenn-Colusa Irrigation District (GCID), water transferred under the project originates from Central Valley Project (CVP) allocations of existing surface water supply and does not constitute a new draw on the hydrogeologic system, and the shifting of CVP water use within the basin for irrigation using only existing facilities is consistent with existing conditions. CVP water transferred under the project is not purchased by landowners and water users and is surplus to the needs of GCID in 2024. No land will be fallowed as a result of the project, and the project will not result in any increase in groundwater pumping. The transfer will occur using existing screened water diversion facilities to irrigate existing cropland within SMWC. The amount of water diverted by SMWC under the project will be within the range of historic diversions and consistent with established irrigation uses. Annual variations in CVP water use within GCID and SMWC, and in Sacramento River Flows, are normal and under the project would be within existing ranges.
