PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project referred to internally as Springville Waste Water Planning Assistance. The objective of the Planning Project is to investigate alternatives and to develop additional long-term disposal capacity to meet projected wastewater flows.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on May 21, 2024, and determined that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act. The Springville Public Utility District will be carrying out the Project.
